
## Low Wall Dungeon Plans



## You will need 24 castings of mold #350 to do this project.

Print these color sheets onto self adhesive label paper. I suggest Avery #8165. Be sure the print is 100% actual size by measuring the 1" squares using a ruler.



Stick these sheets down to black foam core board or something stiff but easily cut. Use a hobby knife to cut out the halls and rooms on the thin black lines.





Spray paint the blocks flat black before gluing them onto the floors. You will use about 3 cans of spray paint.



Glue the blocks around the rooms according to the letters around the outside edges.



Dry brush a Imedium gray onto the walls. You can cut out the masks on the last page in order to help you paint without getting paint onto the floors.





Glue the blocks labeled "P" on each side of the doors after painting.





Use the last pages of these plans to make custom rooms of your own design.


